

Terms and Conditions for Kaiteriteri Recreation Reserve (KRR) Bus Service

Booking and Reservations:

All bookings are subject to seat availability.

Reservations can be made through the KRR website.

Payment for reservations must be made in full at the time of booking.

Ticketing:

Tickets are non-transferable and non-refundable.

Passengers are required to present a valid ID along with the ticket before boarding.

Lost, stolen, or damaged tickets may not be replaceable.

Boarding and Departure:

Passengers must arrive at the designated boarding point at least 15 minutes before the scheduled departure time.

The bus will depart on time, and the company will not be liable for any losses incurred due to a passenger's late arrival.

Luggage and Personal Belongings:

KRR will not be responsible for any loss or damage to luggage or personal belongings during transit.

Conduct Onboard:

Passengers are expected to behave respectfully towards other passengers and the bus staff.

Smoking, consuming alcohol, or any illegal substances are strictly prohibited on the bus.

Any disruptive behavior or refusal to comply with the bus staff's instructions may result in removal from the bus without a refund.

Delays and Interruptions:

While the KRR endeavors to maintain punctuality, delays due to traffic, weather, or other circumstances beyond our control may occur. We appreciate your understanding in such situations.

Liability:

KRR will not be liable for any injury, loss, damage, delay, or inconvenience caused during the bus journey unless due to the company's proven negligence.
